
Bees in the Old Burial Ground:

Work is progressing in using an area of the Old Burial Ground to house some Bees, and an enclosure has been constructed ready for the bees to arrive. We will bring you more news about the exploits of the bees soon.



SID Statistics Mark Cross:

The SID device has recently been deployed in Mark Cross and recorded the speed through the centre of the village.





The graph compares the speed and number of vehicles for the same area and period in 2017 and 2020 for the month of April. There is no significant increase in speed, about 1mph on average speed between now and then but obviously fewer vehicles due to the Coronavirus lockdown. The majority of vehicles travel through the village at a speed of 35-39mph. We are continuing to look at methods for tackling speeding drivers throughout the Parish.

The Parish Council will continue to deploy the SID around the parish and share its findings with East Sussex County Council Highways.

Council Success 2019-2020:

As we have had to postpone the Annual Parish Meeting due to Covid-19, we wanted to highlight to you some of the success the council has achieved in the last year:

- The purchase of the surgery was completed at the end of March 2019; hopefully assuring
 the continuation of the GP practice in Rotherfield village. Continued maintenance and
 improvements throughout the year including: new boiler, resurfacing of car park and
 replacement of fascia boards.
- Adoption of Eridge Station through the Adopt a Station Scheme.
- Continual lobbying of East Sussex Highways resulting in the resurfacing of Church Road and Rotherfield Hill.
- Working with Rotherfield & Mark Cross Bonfire Society the first Rotherfield In Bloom took place in April 2019.
- Repair and restoration of the Beacon in Rotherfield Recreation Ground.
- Repairs, restoration, and renewal of the Old Burial Ground behind St Denys' Church with the support of the Sussex Lund Fund.
- Purchased and committed to the restoration of two telephone kiosks in Rotherfield village.
- Installation of a footpath between the School & Community Centre and Millennium Green Car Park in Mark Cross.
- Maintenance of the Rotherfield Village Hall car park.
- Reintroduction of Councillor Drop In Surgeries across the parish.
- Maintenance and restoration of fingerposts across the parish.
- Lobbying with regard to parking situation on the approach to Eridge Station.
- Funding of Christmas lights across the parish.
- Launch of a new Parish Council website to keep the community connected.
- Working in partnership with Rotherfield St Martin to produce two Parish Newsletters sent to all households in the parish.
- Supporting the establishment of Parish Pals to support the community in responding to COVID-19.
