South East Water:



August saw disruptions to water services across the Parish as a result of leaks on the Five Ashes Road and Luxford Road in Crowborough. Having spoken to South East Water, we can update the road closure to repair the water system has been extended until August 24th and may possibly carry on into September. A temporary fix is currently in place.

Grass Cutting & Maintenance on the Recreation Ground:

The Parish Council has formalised timings for grass cutting and regular maintenance works on the Recreation Ground:

- No cutting to commence before 09:00
- No cutting to continue after 20:00
- Cutting to be limited to 4 hours in any one day continuous or otherwise.
- Cutting to be limited to a cumulative 20hours in any seven day period.
- Cutting operations on a Sunday or Bank Holiday will be minimised and only associated with scheduled Sports Club matches.

Dogs in the Old Burial Ground:

We have received reports from residents about dogs being walked in the Old Burial Ground with large amounts of dog mess being left behind by owners. The Parish Council does not allow dogs in the Old Burial Ground, but owners are permitted to walk their dogs on Court Meadow Green provided they clean up after their dogs. New signage will be going up in the Old Burial Ground as a reminder to residents. Thank you for your support with this.
