We would like to say a big thank you to all those business, organisations and households who have taken part in Rotherfield Blooming Marvellous. It is great to see the parish so beautifully decorated.










SID – Milk Lodge – Vehicles entering Rotherfield from Jarvis Brook:

Wealdlink:

At our recent Highways, Lighting & Transport Committee Meeting, it was agreed that we would make a grant of £1,500.00 to continue our support for the North Wealden Community Transport Partnership for bus services (Wealdlink).

East Sussex Libraries:

All East Sussex libraries have reopened and residents can once again borrow, return and reserve items. Computers are available to pre-book, and study space and Job Pods for online job interviews are available at selected libraries. Customers can reserve up to 10 items, with existing and new library loans extended until 30 June.

The libraries are Covid-secure with new layouts to encourage social distancing, limited visitor numbers, and increased cleaning. Books will be quarantined for 72 hours upon return and for the time being newspapers will only be available online. Library events have not yet resumed but will be returning over the coming months.
