Speedwatch:



Rotherfield Speedwatch group is up and running once again thanks to the sterling efforts of former Councillor Angela Moore. We at present have nine members but could always do with more help. It requires no more time than you can spare, however small. We have been out three times so far and it has resulted in 51 reports of excessive speed to Sussex Police, it has also been noticed that a number of drivers still feel it is acceptable to use their phones whilst driving; this has been noted and entered on our report to the Police. Many of the transgressors are locals

so please slow down, this will result in those passing through also having to slow down, making the Parish a safer place for all. We at present only have two approved locations but have applied for eight more. If you are interested in helping, please contact the Council.

SID:

SID our vehicle speed indication device and recorder has been in various locations recently and is at present situated near the Primary school for their return. It's data, which is shared with the Police through the Sussex Safer Roads Partnership, shows that the majority of vehicles are travelling at an appropriate speed or just above, however there are still too many motorists who find it necessary to drive at excessive speed and the odd few who achieve levels which are beyond belief in a Village centre. SID will be continue to be deployed at perceived "Hot Spots" and its results shared to help



planning for Road Safety improvements, although SID's recordings are anonymous the results of "Speedwatch" are not! Please drive & park considerately to make the parish a better, safer place for all.

The council are pleased to see works are progressing on the installation of the new lift at Eridge Station.








